

We are opposed to HB 405—revise seed contract law—genetically engineered wheat seed because: 1) it stifles research here in Montana and nationally in crops we grow Montana; 2) it will put the brakes on rural economic opportunities in Montana; 3) the legislation is premature—earliest possible introduction of biotech wheat is six years in the future; 4) damage for loss of markets is a possible danger now but world opinion is gradually moving toward acceptance—especially with our most important trading partners in Pacific Rim, and 5) we question that the legislation is even legal.
