9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Grandfather clause. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), if the
12	commission approves a new classification of service for customer-generators in accordance with this part or
13	69-3-306, the new rate applies only to customer-generators interconnecting net metering systems on or after the
14	date on which the commission adopts a final order implementing the new classification.
15	(2) (a) A customer-generator that interconnects a net metering system prior to commission approval of
16	a new classification of service for customer-generators may accept service under the new classification of service
17	at any time.
18	(b) After accepting service under a new classification of service, the customer-generator may not return
19	to its original classification of service.
20	
21	Section 2. Section 69-3-306, MCA, is amended to read:
22	"69-3-306. Classification of service. (1) The Except as provided in [section 1], the commission may
23	prescribe classifications of the service of all public utilities. Such classifications Classifications may take into
24	account the quantity used, the time when used, and any other reasonable consideration. Each A public utility is
25	required to shall conform its schedule of rates, tolls, and charges to such the classifications.
26	(2) The commission shall prescribe a declining block rate structure for electric service, when
27	cost-justified."

29	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
30	integral part of Title 69, chapter 8, part 6, and the provisions of Title 69, chapter 8, part 6, apply to [section 1].
