| 12 | Section 1. Section 69-3-601, MCA, is amended to read:   |
| 13 | "69-3-601. (Temporary) Definitions. As used in this part, the following definitions apply:                  |
| 14 | (1) "Commission" means the Montana public service commission.   |
| 15 | (2) "Electric cooperative" means a rural electric cooperative organized under the laws of Montana, or       |
| 16 | a foreign corporation admitted to do business in Montana.   |
| 17 | (3) "Long-term contracts" means contracts for 10 years or more.   |
| 18 | (3)(4) "Qualifying small power production facility" means a facility that:                                  |
| 19 | (a) produces electricity by the use, as a primary energy source, of biomass, waste, water, wind, or other   |
| 20 | renewable resource, or any combination of those sources; or   |
| 21 | (b) produces electricity and useful forms of thermal energy, such as heat or steam, used for industrial     |
| 22 | commercial, heating, or cooling purposes through the sequential use of energy known as cogeneration; and    |
| 23 | (c) has a power production capacity that together with any other facilities located at the same site is not |
| 24 | greater than 80 megawatts; and  |
| 25 | (d) is owned by a person not primarily engaged in the generation or sale of electricity other than electric |
| 26 | power from a small power production facility.   |
| 27 | (4)(5) "Utility" means any public utility supplying electricity and regulated by the commission. (Repealed  |

| 30 | Section 2. Section 69-3-602, MCA, is amended to read:   |
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| 1  | "69-3-602. (Temporary) Generation and sale of electricity by qualifying small power production  |
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| 2  | facility. (1) A qualifying small power production facility may generate electricity from the sources described in                                     |
| 3  | 69-3-601 <del>(3)(a) and (3)(b)(4)(a) and (4)(b)</del> and may contract for the sale of that electricity with a utility.                              |
| 4  | (2) A qualifying small power production facility may generate electricity from the sources described in   |
| 5  | 69-3-601 <del>(3)(a) and (3)(b)(4)(a) and (4)(b)</del> and may contract for the sale of that electricity with an electric                             |
| 6  | cooperative under terms and conditions mutually agreed upon between the parties and in compliance with the  |

| 10 | Section 3. Section 69-3-604, MCA, is amended to read:   |
| 11 | "69-3-604. (Temporary) Standards for determination of rates and conditions. (1) The commission  |
| 12 | shall determine the rates and conditions of the contract for the sale of electricity by a qualifying small power                                      |
| 13 | production facility according to the standards in subsections (2) through (5).  |
| 14 | (2) (a) Long-term Except as provided in subsection (2)(b), the commission shall require long-term   |
| 15 | contracts for the purchase of electricity by the utility from a qualifying small power production facility must be                                    |
| 16 | encouraged in order to enhance the economic feasibility of qualifying small power production facilities.  |
| 17 | (b) If a qualifying small power production facility requests that the commission require a contract for a time  |
| 18 | period shorter than a long-term contract, the commission may require the shortened contract length.   |
| 19 | (3) The rates to be paid by a utility for electricity purchased from a qualifying small power production  |
| 20 | facility must be established with consideration of the availability and reliability of the electricity produced.                                      |
| 21 | (4) The commission shall set these rates using the avoided cost over the term of the contract.  |
