I am privileged to be enjoying my 6 year anniversary as Belgrade City Court Judge this week. I reflect back fondly on my term with the Petra Academy Board and the high standards for professionalism and integrity you expected of us and the professionals that worked in and for the school.

I have known Judge Peter Ohman for seventeen years. He meets your standards for professionalism and integrity squarely. Judge Ohman has been a friend, mentor and colleague of mine in the trenches. He is not an ideologue. Like justices of the peace and magistrate judges, district judges are amongst the 'workhorses' of the judicial system.
