 A life insurance company that declines to pay a claim made by a life insurance policy beneficiary on the basis that the insured failed to disclose a treating health care provider when the purpose of the treatment or consultation had no direct causal relationship to what ultimately formed the medical basis for the insured's death is an unfair or deceptive act or practice in the conduct of trade or commerce subject to the provisions of Title 33, chapter 18.
- (2) (a) Whenever the department has reason to believe that a life insurance company is using, has used, or is about to knowingly use any method, act, or practice provided for in subsection (1) as an unfair or deceptive act or practice in the conduct of trade or commerce within the meaning of Title 33, chapter 18, and that proceeding would be in the public interest, the department may bring an action against the life insurance company to restrain by temporary or permanent injunction or temporary restraining order the unlawful method, act, or practice after giving appropriate notice to that life insurance company.
- (b) In an action brought under this section, the commissioner may assess a penalty as provided in 33-1-317 and 33-1-318 if:
- (i) a court finds that a life insurance company is willfully using or has willfully used a method, act, or practice declared unlawful by this section; or
- (ii) a court finds a common scheme or practice by a life insurance company declared unlawful by this section.
- (3) In addition to other remedies provided for by law, a beneficiary of an insured has a private right of action for a violation of this section that entitles the beneficiary to damages equal to three times the face value of the life insurance policy and attorney fees.
- (4) All private legal actions under this section must be brought in the county in which the insured was domiciled at the time of the insured's death.
- (5) For the purposes of this section, "life insurance company" means an insurer transacting insurance business subject to Title 33, chapter 20."
