7	driving offenses; defining a DUI court; revising and clarifying

9	61-8-714 and $61-8-722$, MCA; and providing an applicability date."

11	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Montana:

13	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Suspension of imprisonment
14	sentence for DUI court participation DUI court defined. (1) If
15	a person participates in a DUI court, the court may, at the
16	court's discretion, suspend all or a portion of an imprisonment
17	sentence under $61-8-714$ or $61-8-722$, except for the mandatory
18	minimum imprisonment term.
19	(2) If a person participating in a DUI court fails to
20	comply with the conditions imposed by the DUI court, the court
21	shall revoke the suspended imprisonment sentence and the
22	imprisonment sentence must commence from the effective date of
23	the revocation.
24	(3) For purposes of this section, "DUI court" means any
25	court that has established a special docket for handling cases
26	involving persons convicted under 61-8-401 or 61-8-406 and that
27	implements a program of incentives and sanctions intended to

- 1 assist a participant to complete treatment ordered pursuant to
- 2 61-8-732 and to end the participant's criminal behavior
- 3 associated with driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- 4 or with excessive blood alcohol concentration.

- 8 **or drugs -- first through third offense.** (1) (a) Except as
- 9 provided in subsection (4), a person convicted of a $\underline{\text{first}}$
- violation of 61-8-401 shall be punished by imprisonment for not
- less than 24 consecutive hours or more than 6 months 1 year and
- by a fine of not less than \$300 or more than \$1,000, except that
- if one or more passengers under 16 years of age were in the
- vehicle at the time of the offense, the person shall be punished
- by imprisonment for not less than 48 consecutive hours or more
- than 12 months 1 year and by a fine of not less than \$600 or more
- 17 than \$2,000.

- (2) (a) Except as provided in subsection (4), on a second conviction, the person shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$600 or more than \$1,000 and by imprisonment for not less than 7 days or more than 6 months 1 year, except that if one or more passengers under 16 years of age were in the vehicle at the time of the offense, the person shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$1,200 or more than \$2,000 and by imprisonment for not less than 14 days or more than 12 months 1 year.
- (b) At least 48 hours of the 7-day The mandatory minimum imprisonment term must be served and served consecutively and may not be served under home arrest. The imposition or execution of the first 5 days of the imprisonment sentence may not be suspended and may not be suspended unless the judge finds that the imposition of the imprisonment sentence will pose a risk to the person's physical or mental well-being.
- (c) Except for the initial 5 days of the imprisonment term, notwithstanding 46-18-201(2), the The remainder of the imprisonment sentence may be suspended for a period of up to 1 year pending the person's successful completion of a chemical dependency treatment program by the person pursuant to 61-8-732.
- (3) (a) Except as provided in subsection (4), on the third conviction, the person shall be punished by imprisonment for a term of not less than 30 days or more than 1 year and by a fine of not less than \$1,000 or more than \$5,000, except that if one or more passengers under 16 years of age were in the vehicle at the time of the offense, the person shall be punished by

- 26 "61-8-722. Penalty for driving with excessive alcohol concentration -- first through third offense. (1) (a) Except as 27 provided in subsection (4), a person convicted of a violation of 28 61-8-406 shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than $\frac{10}{10}$ 29

days 1 year and by a fine of not less than \$300 or more than \$1,000, except that if one or more passengers under 16 years of age were in the vehicle at the time of the offense, the person shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than 20 days 1 year and by a fine of not less than \$600 or more than \$2,000.

- (2) (a) Except as provided in subsection (4), on a second conviction of a violation of 61-8-406, the person shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than 5 7 days, to be served in the county jail and not on home arrest, or more than 30 days 1 year and by a fine of not less than \$600 or more than \$1,000, except that if one or more passengers under 16 years of age were in the vehicle at the time of the offense, the person shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than 10 days, which may not be served on home arrest, or more than 60 days 1 year and by a fine of not less than \$1,200 or more than \$2,000.
