- (i) overtime, holiday payments, shift differential payments, compensatory time payments, and payments in lieu of sick leave.
- (ii) maintenance, allowances, and expenses

This also exists in MPORS, MCA 19-9-104

The legislation should be changed to make all retirement systems equal when defining compensation for purposes of retirement.
