Rule: "Owner of any commercial weighing or measuring device is responsible for its accuracy and must have it tested once every 15 months." May use Commission or a registered service person."

Rule: No specific testing schedule - by complaint.
WASHINGTON	Department of Agriculture	Set in Statute-Annual Fee Motor Fuel - 20 gpm - \$10. Petroleum Meter - 20-150 gpm - \$32. Petroleum Meter - 150 gpm+ - \$50. LPG Meters small - \$25. LPG Meters - large - \$50.	Code: "Shall test in each biennium a sufficient number of devices to ensure public safety" Rule: None in effect.
WYOMING	Department of Agriculture	Set in Rule-Annual Fee (Based on number of dispensers or meters at the establishment.) 1 to 5 meters - \$25. 5-11 memters - \$50. 11 or more meters - \$75.	Code: Broad powers to director to enact rules. Rule: Truck meters, LPG meters & Bulk Meters tested annually. Gas pumps tested every three years.

Nevada - Annual fees, higher than MT, annual testing. New Mexico - No license fees, annual testing done by Bureau.
