VETERANS

PUT VETERAN ON YOUR DRIVER LICENSE





Starting January 1, 2014, Montana law lets a qualified veteran add the word "VETERAN" to the front of their driver license or identification (ID) card. This designation not only recognizes your service; it may also help you qualify for veteran discounts offered by some businesses.

INTERESTED? Complete these two steps:

- 1. Confirm your veteran status with the State of Montana Veteran Affairs Division (see the list of service offices below).
- 2. Then use MVD form 21-3000 (you can find it online) to apply for a replacement driver license or ID card at the Motor Vehicle Division. You can apply online, by mail, or in person at a driver exam station.
