^{**} Section 13-1-107, MCA, provides that odd-year primaries are for elections held under 13-1-104(2), which are to nominate municipal officers, officers of single-county districts not required to hold annual elections, and any other officers specified by law for election in odd-numbered years when the term of office will expire before the next scheduled election.

^{***} Sec. of State's Office notes there are no county primary elections they know of in odd years, even though sections 13-1-107(2) and 13-1-104(2), MCA, seem to imply there could be.
