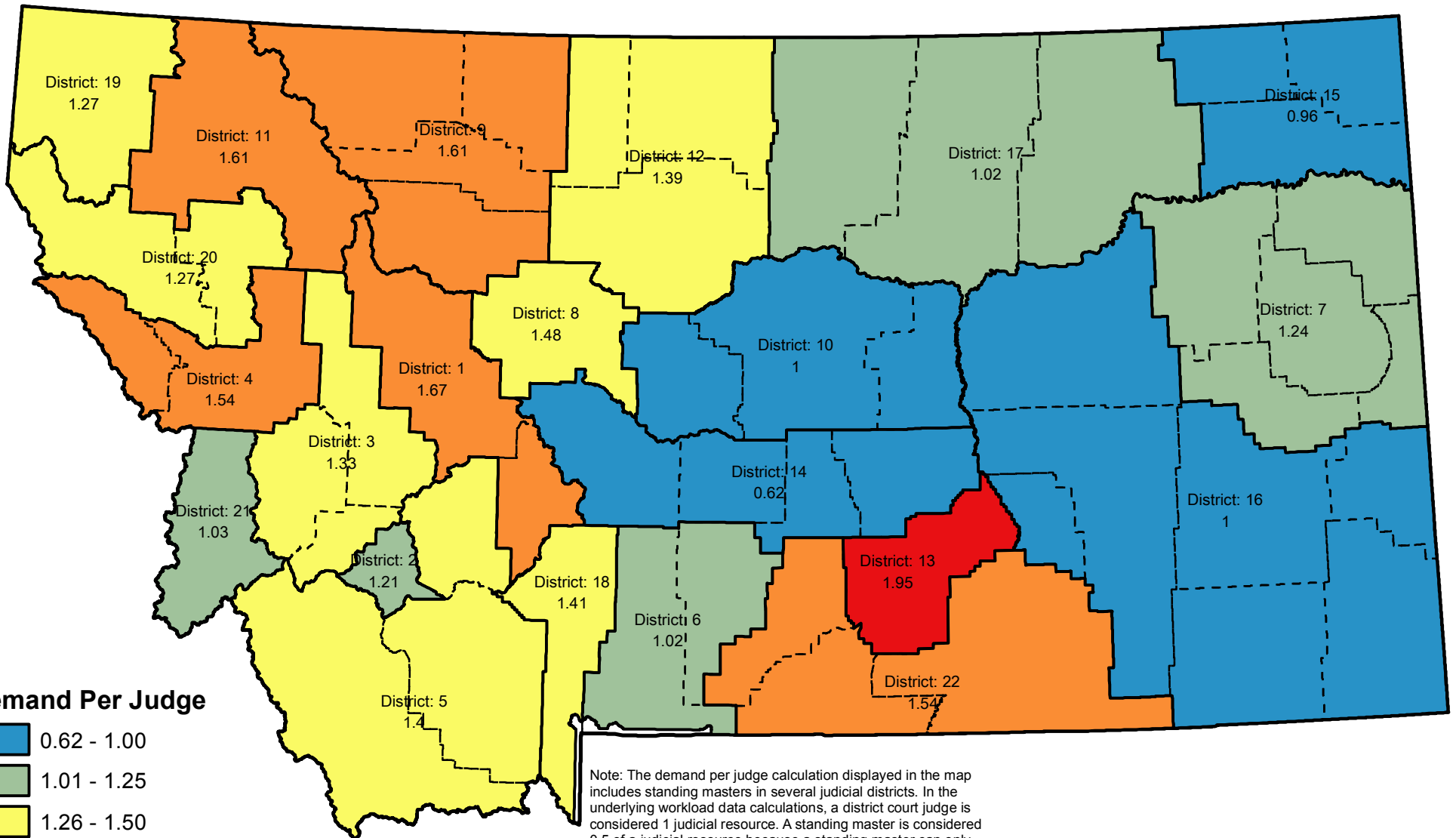


Total Judicial Demand Per Allocated Judge, 2015



Demand Per Judge

- 0.62 - 1.00
- 1.01 - 1.25
- 1.26 - 1.50
- 1.51 - 1.75
- 1.76 - 2.00

The calculated demand per judge is listed below each district number.

Note: The demand per judge calculation displayed in the map includes standing masters in several judicial districts. In the underlying workload data calculations, a district court judge is considered 1 judicial resource. A standing master is considered 0.5 of a judicial resource because a standing master can only be assigned certain cases and does not perform all the functions of a district court judge. Including standing masters in the calculation means the actual demand per district court judge might be slightly higher than the map displays in districts with standing masters. The 4th Judicial District has two standing masters. The 8th, 13th, and 18th districts have one standing master each.
