**District Statistics**

- 56 = the number of District Courts (one in each county)
- 22 = judicial districts
- 7 = judicial districts composed of a single county
- 11 = judicial districts composed of two or three counties
- 4 = judicial districts composed of four or more counties
- 1 = judicial district composed of seven counties
- 11 = judicial districts with a single judge
- 5 = judicial districts with 2 judges
- 1 = judicial district with 3 judges
- 4 = judicial districts with 4 judges
- 1 = judicial district with 6 judges

**Judge Statistics**

- G 46 = District Court judges
- G 6 = years in a district court judge's term of office
- G 2 = judges whose seats are up for election in 2016
- G 35 = judges whose seats are up for election in 2018
- G 9 = judges whose seats are up for election in 2020
