# 2009 Legislative Session

Bill	Status	Short Title
SB 45	Died	Clarify disclosure requirements Purpose: to require that certain evidence be disclosed by prosecutors to indigent criminal defendants without costs to the defendant. The legislature asked that OPD, MACO, and the League of Cities and Towns come to a non-legislative solution. This was partially successful; some entities still charge OPD for this activity.

НВ 96	Passed	Allow recovery of public defender costs in certain cases
HB 97	Passed	Amend supervision of Chief Appellate Defender (transferred from the Chief Public Defender to the Commission)
SB 50	Died	Eliminate jail time for certain misdemeanor offenses  Purpose: to reduce OPD caseloads by removing the right to counsel in cases where jail time is rarely imposed.
SB 147	Died	Allow public defender access to jailed persons prior to court appointment  Purpose: to create uniformity in jurisdictions where jails were refusing access to clients.

HB 92	Passed	Remove public defender from certain court definitions
HB 93	Died	Authorize the public defender to award fixed-fee contracts in certain cases  Purpose: this was an effort to reduce expenditures.
HB 103	Died	Authorize conflicts manager to hire attorney for post-conviction cases  Purpose: to reduce contract costs. Budget item also failed.
HB 107	Passed	Revise laws related to legal counsel representation in abuse and neglect cases
SB 53	Died	Revise penalties eliminating jail time for certain misdemeanor offenses  Purpose: see SB 50 (2011)

HB 71	Died	Define income for eligibility for public defender representation  Purpose: clarify definition of "household"

HB 139	Passed	Clarify public defender involvement in eligibility determination
HB 143	Passed	Suspend payment of public defender fee during incarceration

SB 61	Died	Clarify courts' punitive authority Purpose: companion bill to SB 90 to address concerns regarding jail bill in previous session (see below)
SB 90	Died	Revise penalties eliminating jail time for certain misdemeanor offenses  Purpose: see SB 50 (2011) and SB 53 (2013)
