Re: EQC Administrative Rule Review September 2017

This letter constitutes a review of current rules under the authority of the Environmental Quality Ccouncil (EQC).1

Department of Environmental Quality

MAR Notice Number: 17-391

Subject: Adoption of rules pertaining to technologically enhanced naturally occurring material (TENORM) waste.

Summary: The department states that the proposed rules implement the Montana Solid Waste Management Act (MSWMA). The department proposes to have rules covering purpose and applicability, definitions, TENORM waste management system license requirement, acceptance criteria for TENORM waste management systems, prohibitions, design and siting criteria, operation and maintenance, ground water monitoring, liquids restrictions, closure and postclosure care requirements, financial assurance, and TENORM spill reporting requirements. Notes/Hearing: The department held a public hearing on September 7, 2017 and will hold an additional public hearing on September 20, 2017.

Department of Fish, Wildlife, and Parks

MAR Notice Number: 12-473

Subject: Notice of public hearings and extension of comment period on proposed adoption relating to dog training.

Summary: The department will hold several public meetings to consider its proposed rule relating to dog training. The department also amended its proposed new rule relating to game bird nesting areas. The proposed rule now eliminates the proposed definitions for "game

preserve," "management area," and "open fields." The proposed new rule generally provides that a person has the permission of the director to train dogs if it is not more than four dogs per day or more than four dogs per day between September 1 and March 31.

<u>Subject:</u> Amendment and adoption of rules pertaining to recreational use on the Bitteroot River. <u>Summary:</u> The Fish and Wildlife Commission proposes to add a new subsection to 12.11.610. This subsection proposes to prohibit floating on Fridays from July 1 through September 15 from Painted Rocks Dam to Applebury Forest Service Site. The proposed rules contemplate a Bitterroot River Commercial Use Permit and a Bitterroot River Commercial Use Permit Restrictions.

<u>Notes/Hearing:</u> The department will hold public hearings on October 2, 3, and 10, 2017, in Missoula, Hamilton, and Butte.

Department of Natural Resources and Conservation

MAR Notice Number: 36-22-196

<u>Subject:</u> Amendment and repeal of rules pertaining to water right permitting.

<u>Summary:</u> The department proposes to amend 36.12.101 (definitions), 36.12.105 (temporary emergency appropriations), 36.12.107 (filing fee refunds), 36.12.117 (objection to application), 36.12.121 (aquifer testing requirements), 36.12.1301 (permit and change application acceptance), 36.12.1501 (permit and change application deficiency letter and termination), 36.12.1702 (permit application criteria -- physical surface water availability), and 36.12.1801 (permit and change applications -- beneficial use). The department proposes to repeal 36.12.106 (testing and monitoring). The department states that the rule restates statutory language in 85-2-369 and is not necessary.

<u>Notes/Hearing:</u> The Department will hold a public hearing on October 6, 2017, to consider the proposed rule notice.
