


Fatal Injury Rates

Fatalities by Event or Exposure




50% of all worker deaths in Montana were transportation-related incidents from 2004-2016.

- Workers age 55 and up
- Agricultural industry (ATVs)




Fatalities by Industry

Workers age 45 and up: 71% of fatalities from 2012-2016

- Workers age 55 and up: 46% of fatalities
- Transportation incidents and falls/slips/trips

- ➤ Workers age 55 and up
- ➤ Industries: Agriculture & Construction
- > Small businesses face unique challenges
