Each partisan ballot contains a section that includes nonpartisan offices and applicable ballot issues.

Although electors can view all of the applicable ballots, Montana statute allows for only one party ballot to be submitted.(13-10-301, MCA)

If electors decide that they want to change which party's ballot they vote, they can select a different ballot at any time. Previous ballot selections will not be retained.




