Student Teaching at MSU:

- Local student teaching placement –live on (or near) campus; standard length (70 days)
- 2. Out-of-area student teaching placement
 - Rural live off-campus with or without MSU student teachers nearby;
 may apply for rural student teaching scholarship funds; standard length
 - ii. Rural pod live off-campus with other MSU student teachers; receive \$4000 scholarship from ASPIRE grant; standard length
 - iii. Out of area-non rural student teaching placement live off-campus, for students who want to teach out of state and/or return home or wish to student teach abroad

Yet, as a result of $\underline{HB~833}$ passed during the 2023 Montana legislative session, there is another option.

- Year-long Teacher Residency live off-campus with or without other MSU student teachers nearby; fall coursework is completed online, practicum and student teaching are completed in same school as part of year-long residency
 - Extensive full school year experience with supported Teacher Leader
 - \$1400 monthly stipend (valued at \$12,600 for 9 months)
 - Up to \$3000 in tuition waiver
 - Housing assistance (varies by district and resident)
 - Must commit to teaching in a Montana school for 3 years after completing the year-long Teacher Residency

->The post-graduation teaching commitment is a key strategy for addressing the teacher shortage across the state.

The year-long Teacher Residency is most attractive to students scheduled to student teach in the spring (as soon as Spring 2025); the challenge is that it requires the final year fall coursework be available online (as soon as Fall 2024).

The Opportunity: Create online coursework for MSU teaching majors to participate in the Teacher Residency (TR). Share coursework on the MUS-maintained platform enabling secondary teaching majors from other Montana EPPs to participate in the TR.
