Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

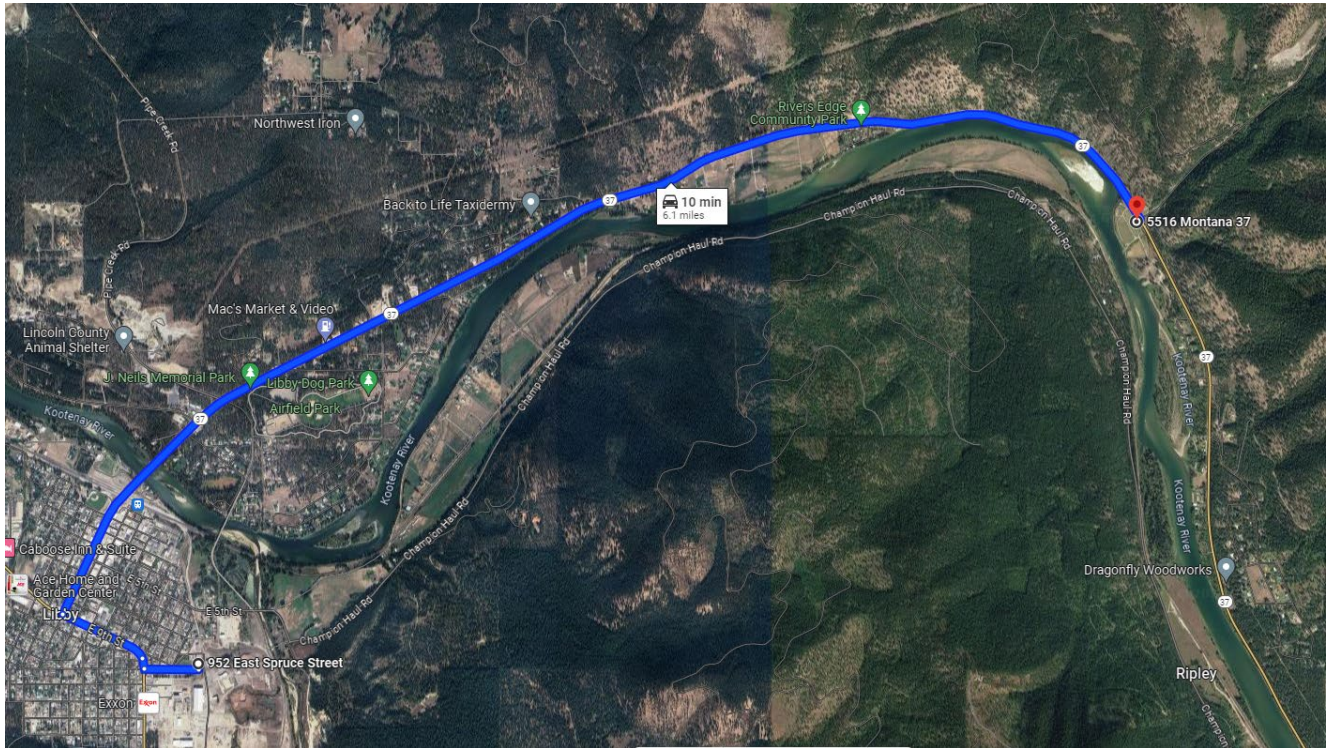
- Visitors **must** wear hard-sole, water-resistant boots (e.g., hiking boots, steel-toed work boots), as shoes will be rinsed with water at stops along the tour. No sandals, high heels, sneakers or soft-sole shoes are permitted.
- Visitors must wear long pants.
- Long-sleeve shirts and hats are recommended for sun protection.

Visitor Safety Rules

1. Access from the Outback to the Libby Superfund Site is only permitted with a designated guide in an authorized vehicle. Visitors may not take their own vehicles beyond the Outback.
2. During the tour, visitors may exit the vehicle at designated sites only as directed by the guide.
3. On the Libby Superfund Site, it is prohibited to pick up or kick rocks or materials from the ground or otherwise generate dust.
4. Throughout the tour, after leaving the vehicle, visitors' shoes will be rinsed prior to re-entering the vehicle.
5. At the end of the tour, visitors' shoes will be rinsed before leaving the site.
6. Our guides reserve the right to prevent personnel from exiting the vehicle at any or all locations due to wind or other conditions.

## Libby OU3 Vehicle Tour Protocol

### Directions form the Ponderosa Room to the Outback (5512 and 5516 MT Highway 37 N)



Head west on E Spruce St toward E 9th St

Turn right onto Minnesota Ave (Minnesota Ave turns left and becomes E 9th St)

Turn right onto California Ave / MT Highway 37 N (signs for Libby Dam/Eureka)

Follow for approximately 5.4 miles to the green shop building directly across from Rainy Creek Rd.
