Programs**

- Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Shelters and Services
- Crisis/Hotlines

**System-Based
Programs**

- County/City Attorney Offices
- Department of Justice Victim Services
- Department of Corrections Victim Services

Governmental departments; integrated into criminal justice system

CACs & CASAs

- Child Advocacy Center (CAC)
- Court-Appointed Special Advocate (CASA)

Specialized non-profits (CACs) or judge-appointed volunteers (CASAs) deeply integrated with justice/welfare systems

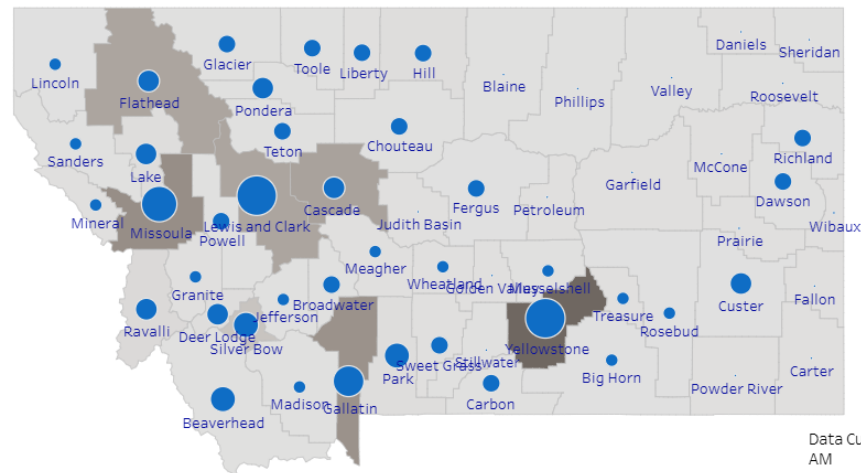

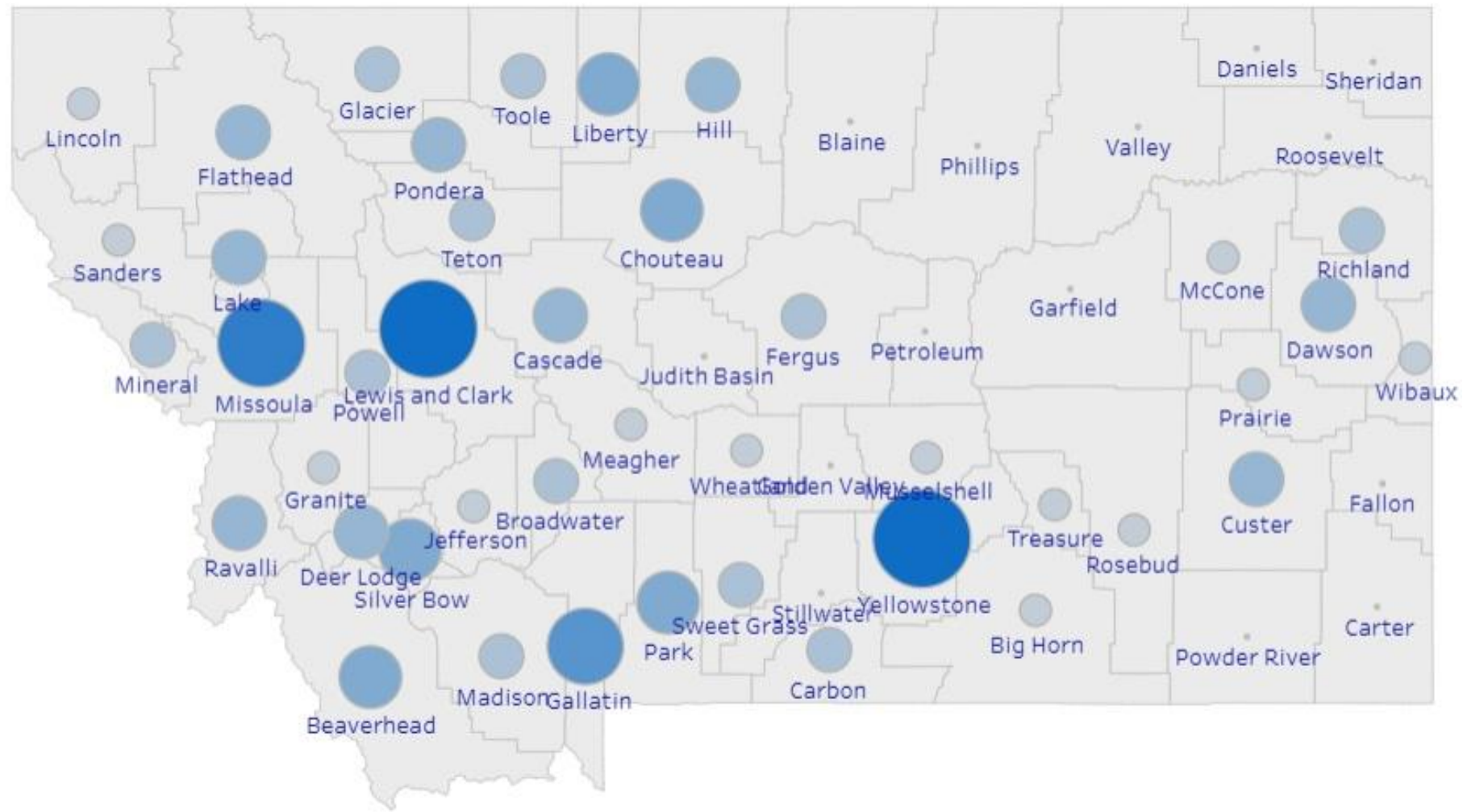
