RE: Analysis of Out-of-District Attendance Report
DATE: March 13, 2026

Back in September, the Education Interim Committee was presented with the first ever [Out of District Attendance Report](#) produced by the Office of Public Instruction. [House Bill No. 203](#) (2023; Bedey) revised Montana's out-of-district attendance laws in various ways, including the requirement that data be collected at the state level and reported annually. This memo contains further analysis of that report.

The first takeaway for most readers of the report was the sheer volume of out-of-district attendance across the state: nearly 11,000 of Montana's 148,000 students attend a school outside their resident school district. Out-of-district attendance is not inherently a good or bad thing. Out-of-district attendance has always required paperwork and often involved some degree of billing. The legislature in recent years has provided greater public school choice through increased open enrollment opportunities and the elimination of parent-paid tuition while trying to ensure taxpayer fairness by mandating district-specific tuition payments so that the costs of educating one district's resident students are not borne so heavily by a neighboring district's taxpayers.

This is probably a good time to acknowledge a couple things:

1. This memo and the tables attached to it use the language "import/export" to describe the out-of-district attendance dynamic. It was not intended to be overly economic or to commodify school children; it was simply the quickest, clearest verbiage that came to mind.
2. Every district has a story. Every instance of out-of-district attendance has a story. Jumping to conclusions about some of the numbers contained in this report would be unsound. There are numerous reasons that a student might attend outside their resident district, including but not limited to:
 - a. Proximity, sometimes driven by old jurisdictional boundaries that ignore more recent demographic realities;
 - b. Parent work locations and afterschool childcare needs;
 - c. Academic or extracurricular offerings/preferences;

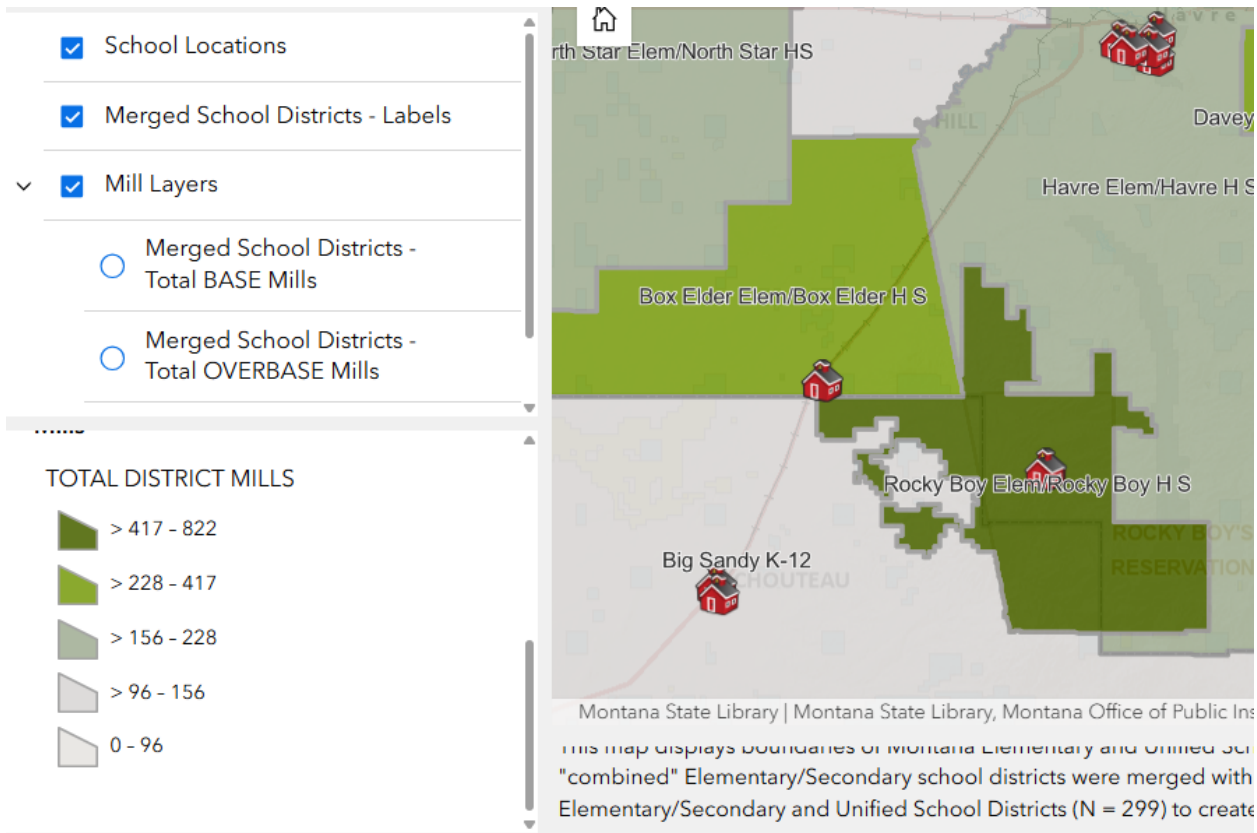
- d. In a handful of places, elementary school districts do not provide certain grades and have long arranged for their 7th and 8th graders, for example, to be educated at a neighboring district.

A second takeaway from the report is that a lot of districts export a large number of their resident students and that a lot of districts import a significant amount of their student bodies. And in some places, there is a whole lot of importing and exporting.

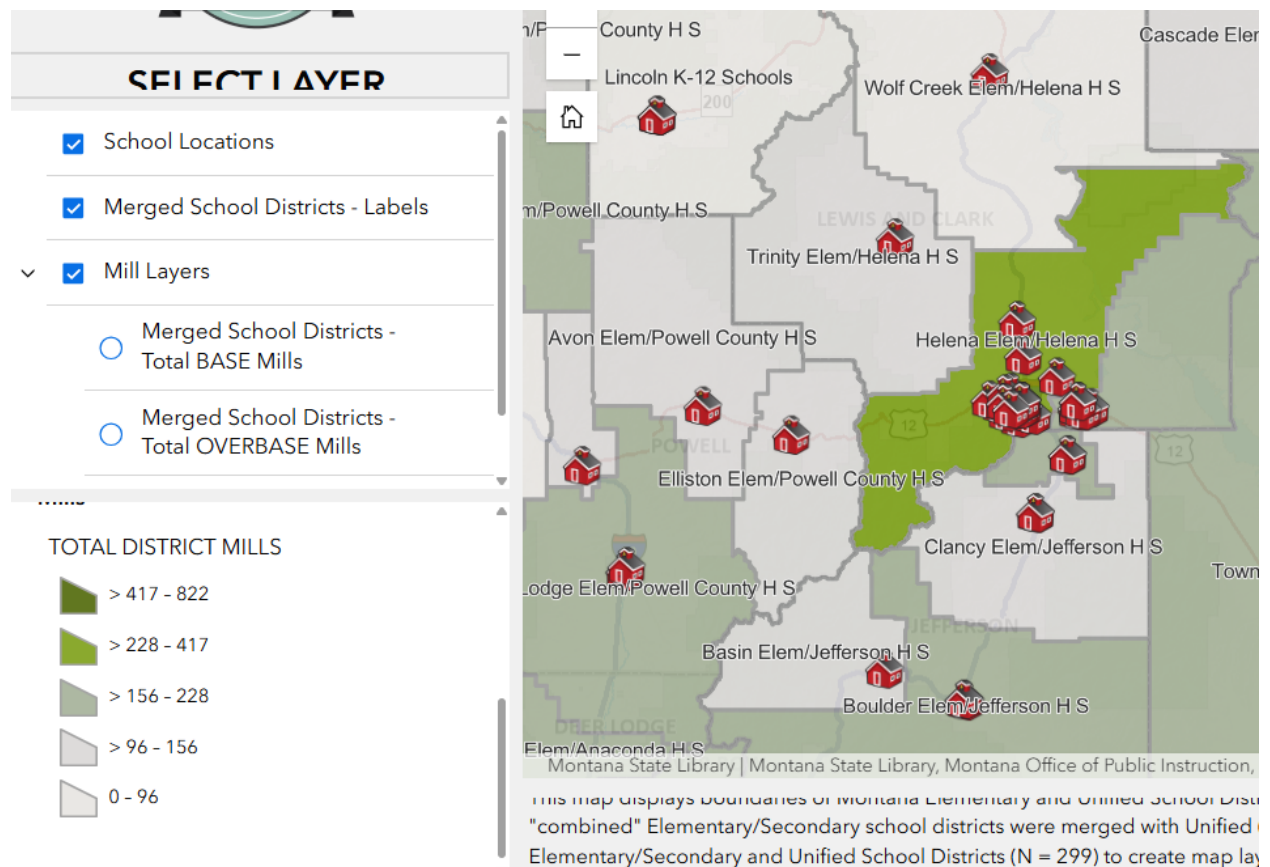

Looking at maps can help tell some of the story in a few of these places. The following snapshots are taken from the [School Funding Maps](#) created by LSD Data Analyst Dan Kayser (note that the mill numbers are for FY 2025 levies which do not reflect increases in tuition levies in FY 2026).

The map below helps explain the large number of students exported by Rocky Boy EL and HS and the large number of students imported by Box Elder schools. The southern boundary line for Box Elder school districts follows the Choteau – Hill County line. There is a lot of housing within several miles of Box Elder schools, just across that line. Many Rocky Boy school district resident children are simply much closer to Box Elder schools.

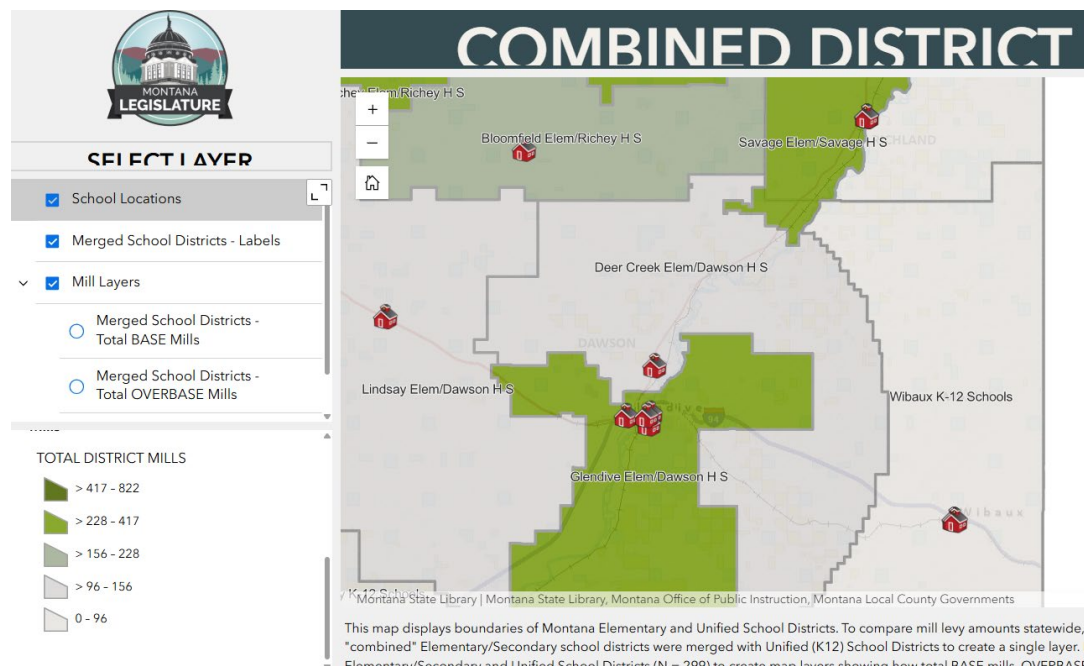
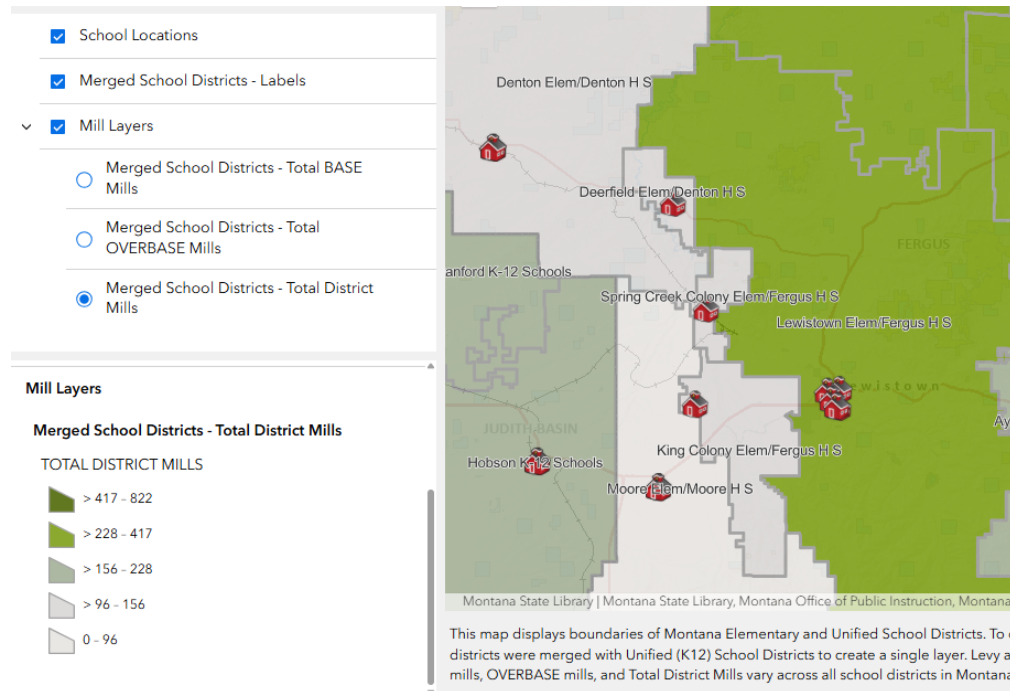


The map below provides another example of this boundary line dynamic and some of the other reasons for out-of-district attendance. The curving line that makes up the southeastern border of the Helena School District boundary is also the Lewis and Clark County line. South of that line, both the Montana City and Clancy Elementary districts feed into Jefferson High School District with the high school located in Boulder. Many, but not all, students on the Helena side of Boulder Hill attend high school in Helena or East Helena. Trinity Elementary District northwest of Helena operates a small country school at Canyon Creek serving grades K-5. It exports a large number of its resident children (123 of 159 resident students), including its 6-8 graders, to Helena.



You will also notice in the tables that follow a concentration of importing/exporting in certain areas (Carbon and Flathead Counties for example). This may be driven by many school districts near each other, by parent work patterns, by families exercising their preference for particular academic or extracurricular offerings, or by a combination of these and other factors.

The following two screenshots show another dynamic: smaller elementary districts with boundaries very close to larger elementary school districts that “feed” into a common high school district. When families in the smaller elementary districts choose (for various reasons) to send their children to the larger elementary school district, the educational costs of those children are transferred but the taxable valuation remains with the smaller elementary district, sometimes leading to large discrepancies in the number of mills levied in each district. The new mandatory tuition levies balance this impact to some degree, but because they are limited to tax burdens within the general fund, large discrepancies often remain.
