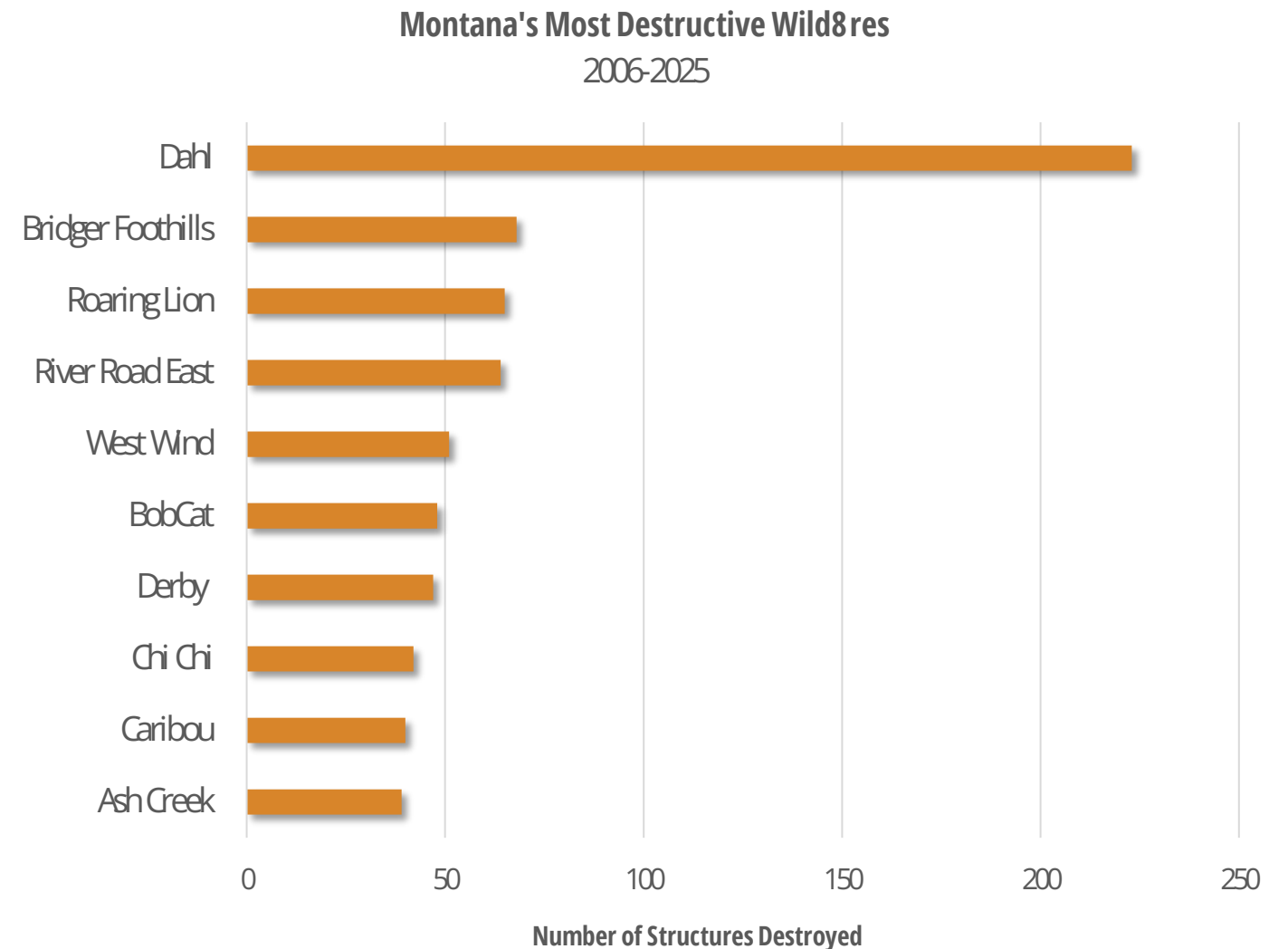

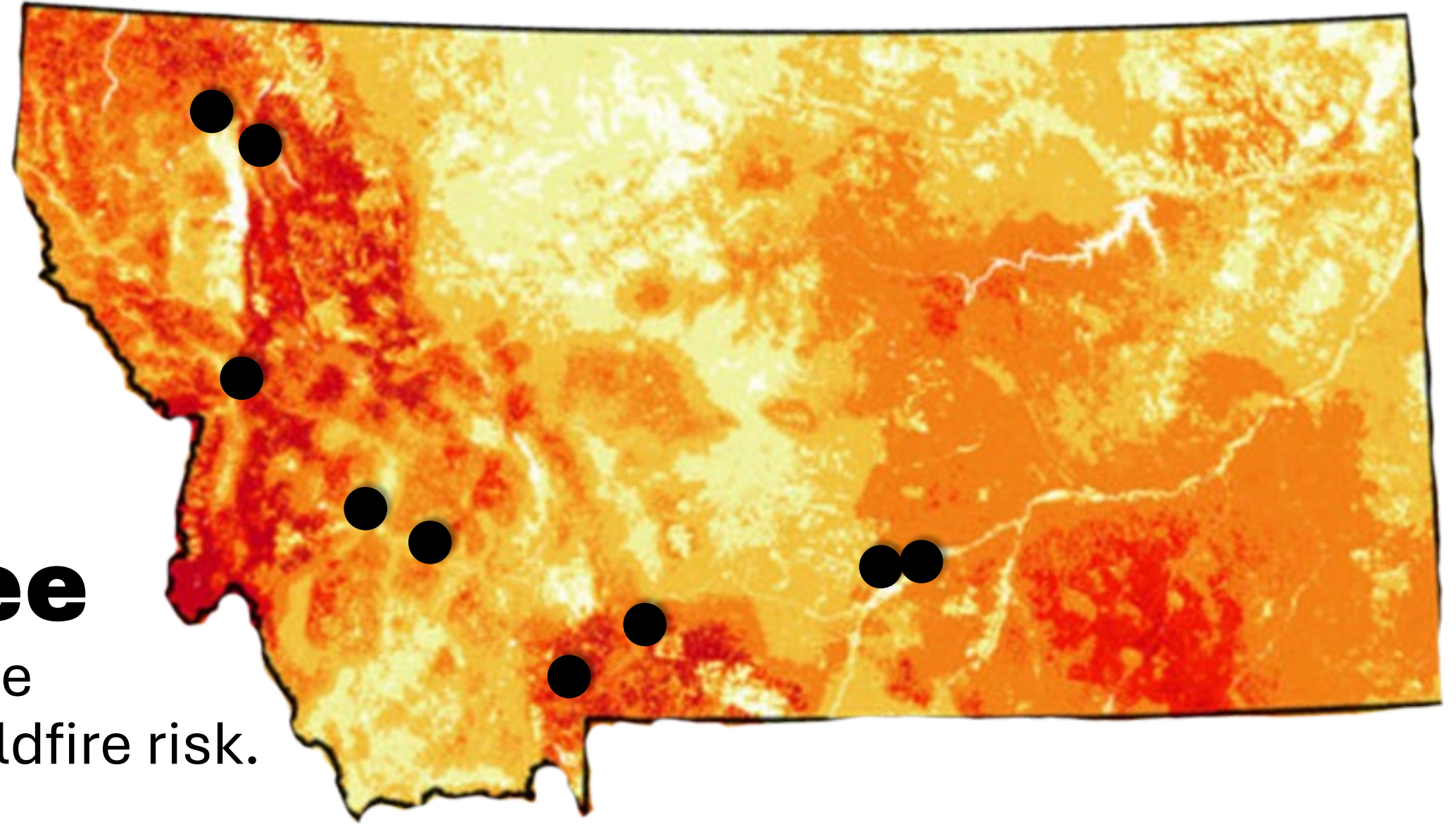
Wildfires are the fastest-growing source of hazard-related insurance damages in the United States.
