

Montana Holdover Senators for 2024 Elections

These are the state senators who were elected to four-year terms in 2022. They will serve two years of the term in the senate district to which they were elected. They will serve the final two years of their term in the district to which they are assigned by the Districting and Apportionment Commission. Commissioners plan to assign the holdover senators to districts on December 15. The public can comment on the entire redistricting plan at a public hearing on December 21 or in writing at any time.
