

ABOUT THE REDISTRICTING COMMISSION

A five-member Districting and Apportionment Commission draws the boundaries of congressional and legislative districts every 10 years. All districts must have approximately the same number of people living within those boundaries. While the Commission seeks recommendations from the Legislature for state legislative districts, the Commission has final authority on district lines. Montana has used a Commission to draw congressional and state legislative districts since 1973.

Commissioners are citizens and may not hold elected office. Four commissioners are appointed by legislative leaders from both major parties. The four members have 20 days to select a fifth member to serve as the presiding officer. If the first four cannot agree, the Montana Supreme Court selects the presiding officer.

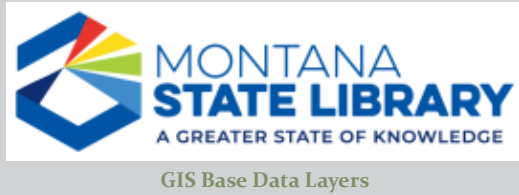
2020 REDISTRICTING COMMISSIONERS

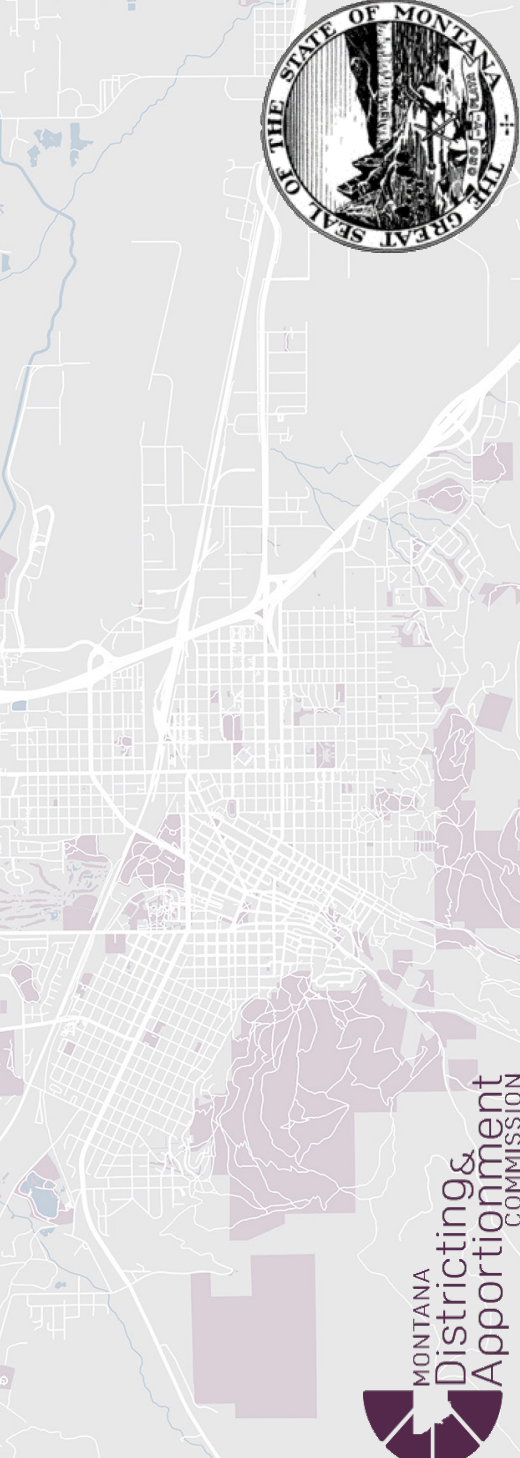

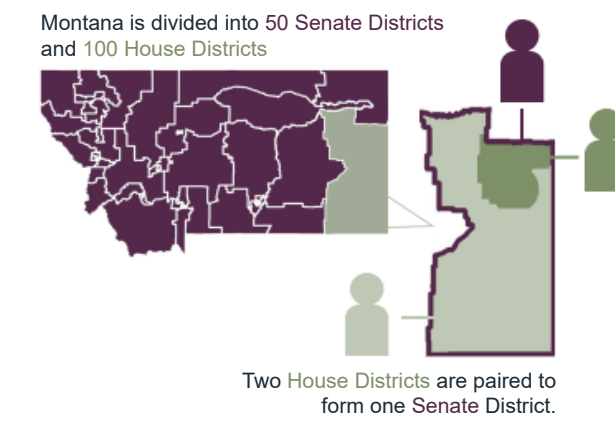
ABOUT THE DISTRICTS

The Montana Legislature has two chambers: the House of Representatives, which has 100 members elected to 2-year terms, and the Senate, which has 50 members elected to 4-year terms. Half of the 50 senators are elected every 2 years. The Legislature holds biennial sessions in odd-numbered years.

CENSUS DATA

Districts apply to elections in 2024 through 2032. Districts are based on the population data captured in the 2020 Census.

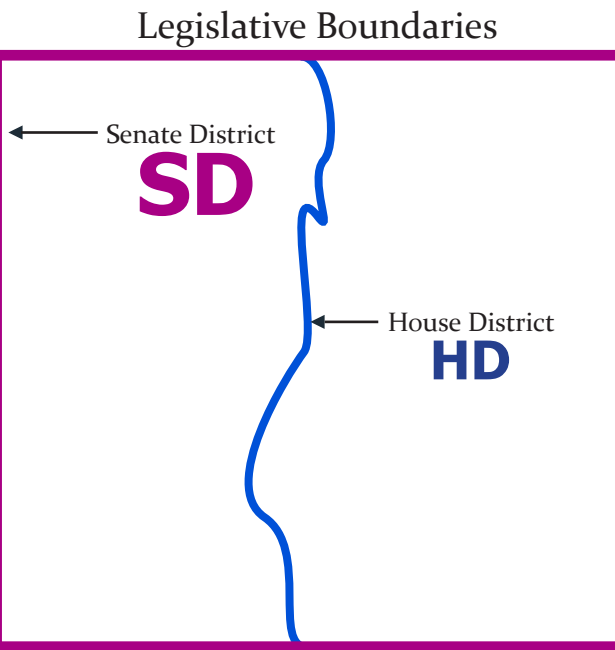
The Commission adjusted the 2020 Census Data used for redistricting by reallocating inmates in state prisons to their last-known home addresses. Based on the prisoner-adjusted 2020 Census Data, the ideal population for each House of Representatives and Senate district is 10,827 and 21,654 people, respectively.



DISTRICT REPRESENTATION

Each Montanan is represented by one state senator and one state representative. Senate districts are made up of two adjoining House districts. Districts may change numbers after every redistricting.

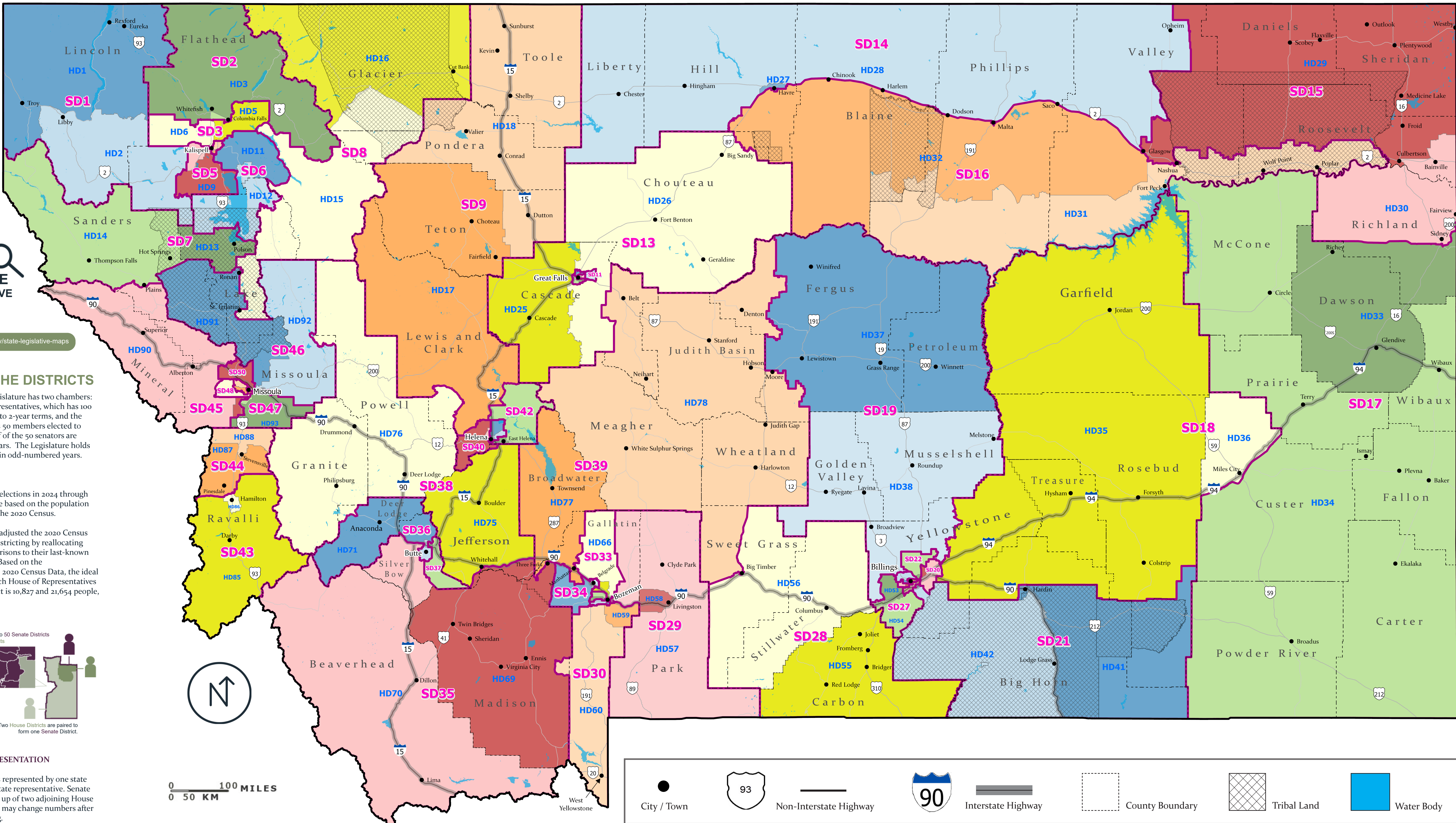
In the map, each Senate District is outlined and labeled in pink. House Districts that form each Senate District are separated by a blue line and labeled in blue.

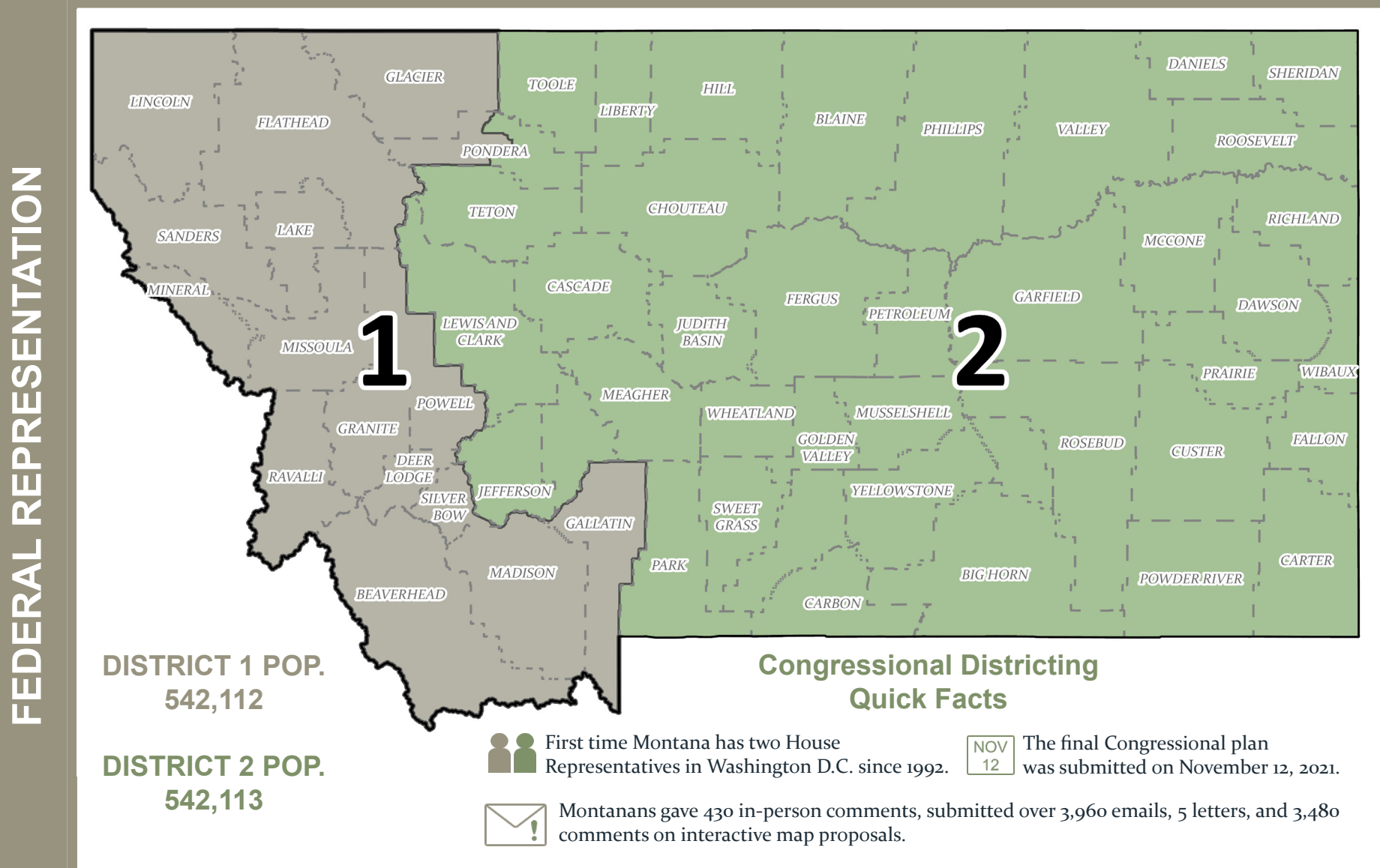

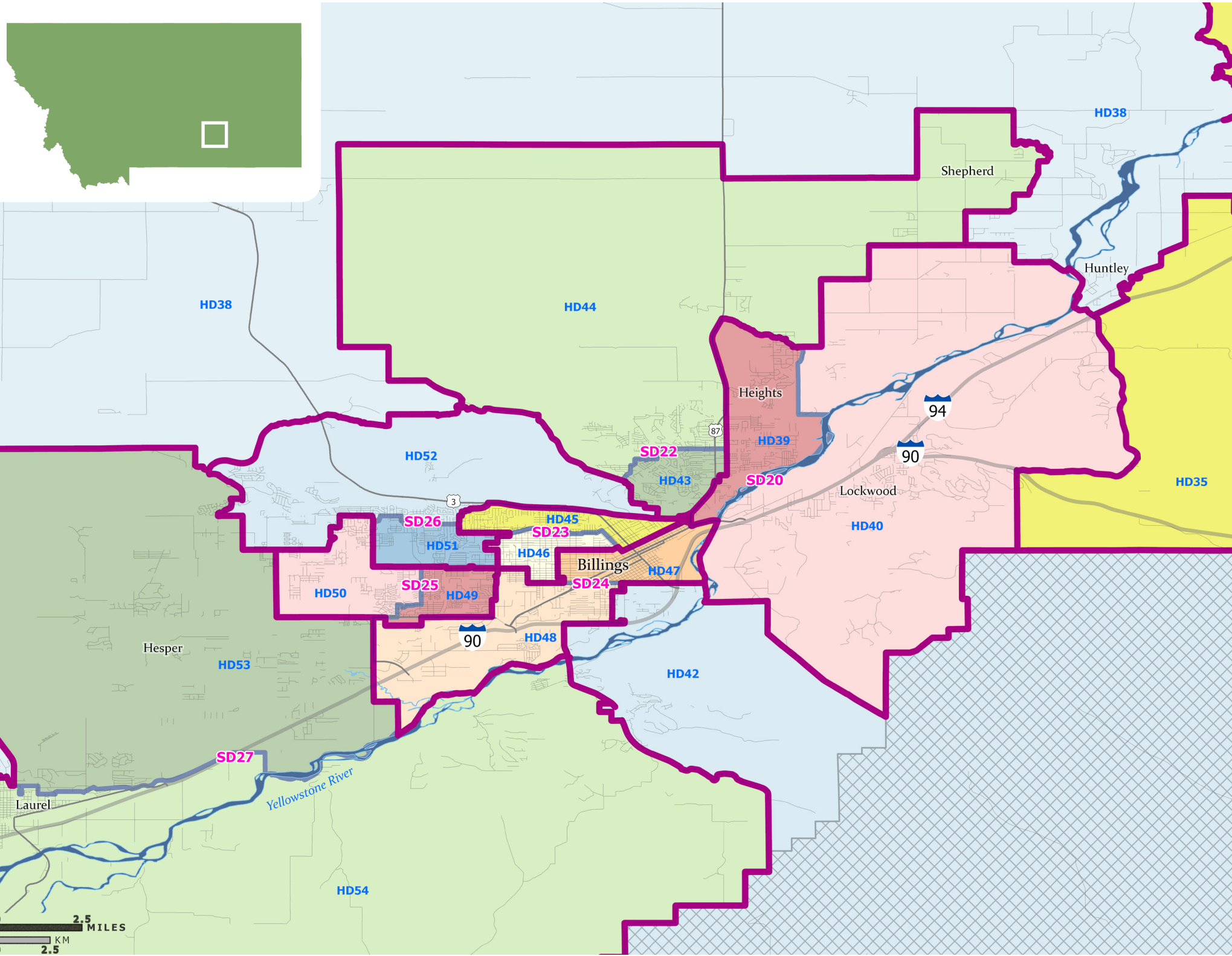

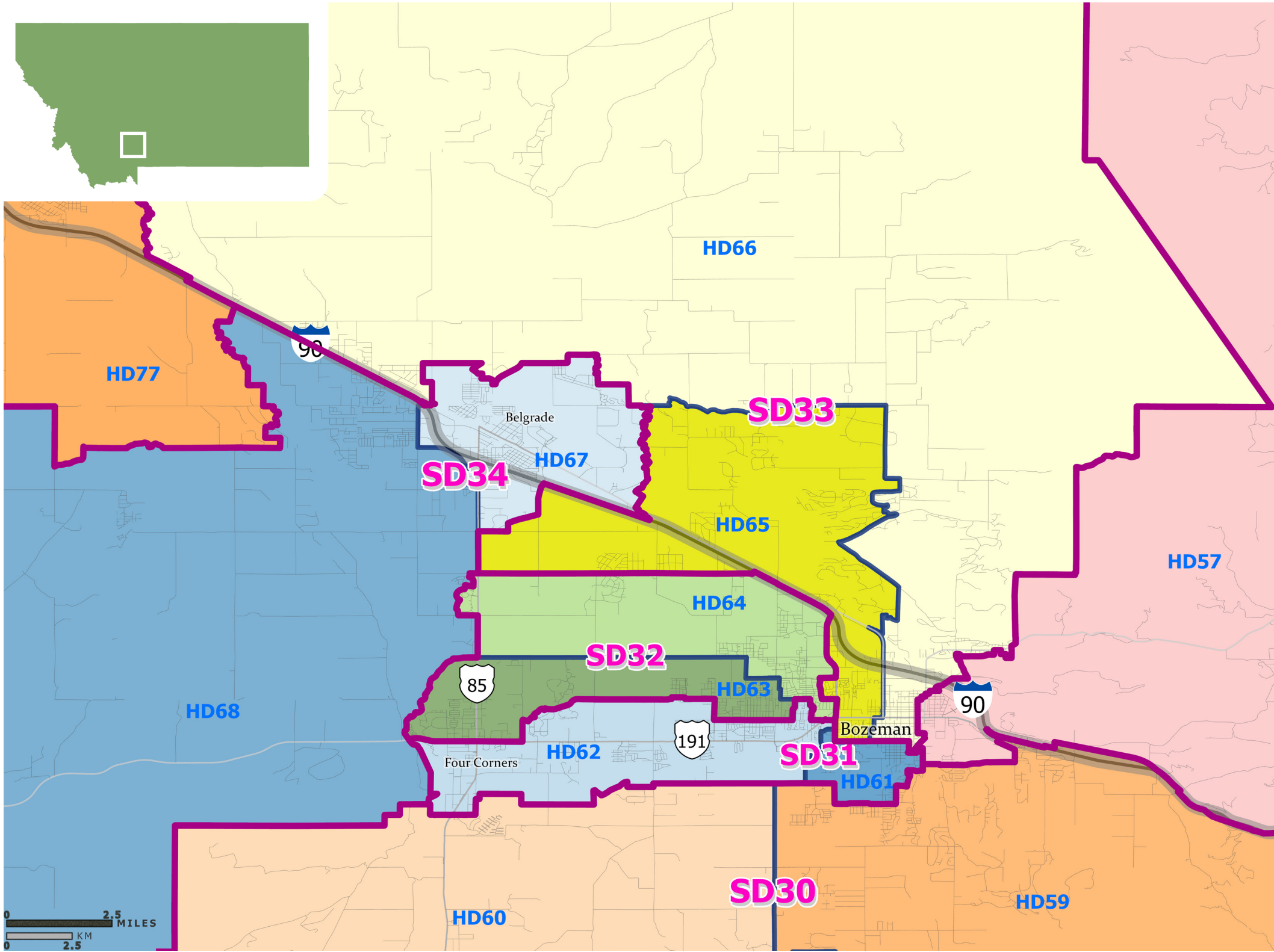
Congressional Districting Quick Facts

First time Montana has two House Representatives in Washington D.C. since 1992. The final Congressional plan was submitted on November 12, 2021. Montanans gave 430 in-person comments, submitted over 3,960 emails, 5 letters, and 3,480 comments on interactive map proposals.

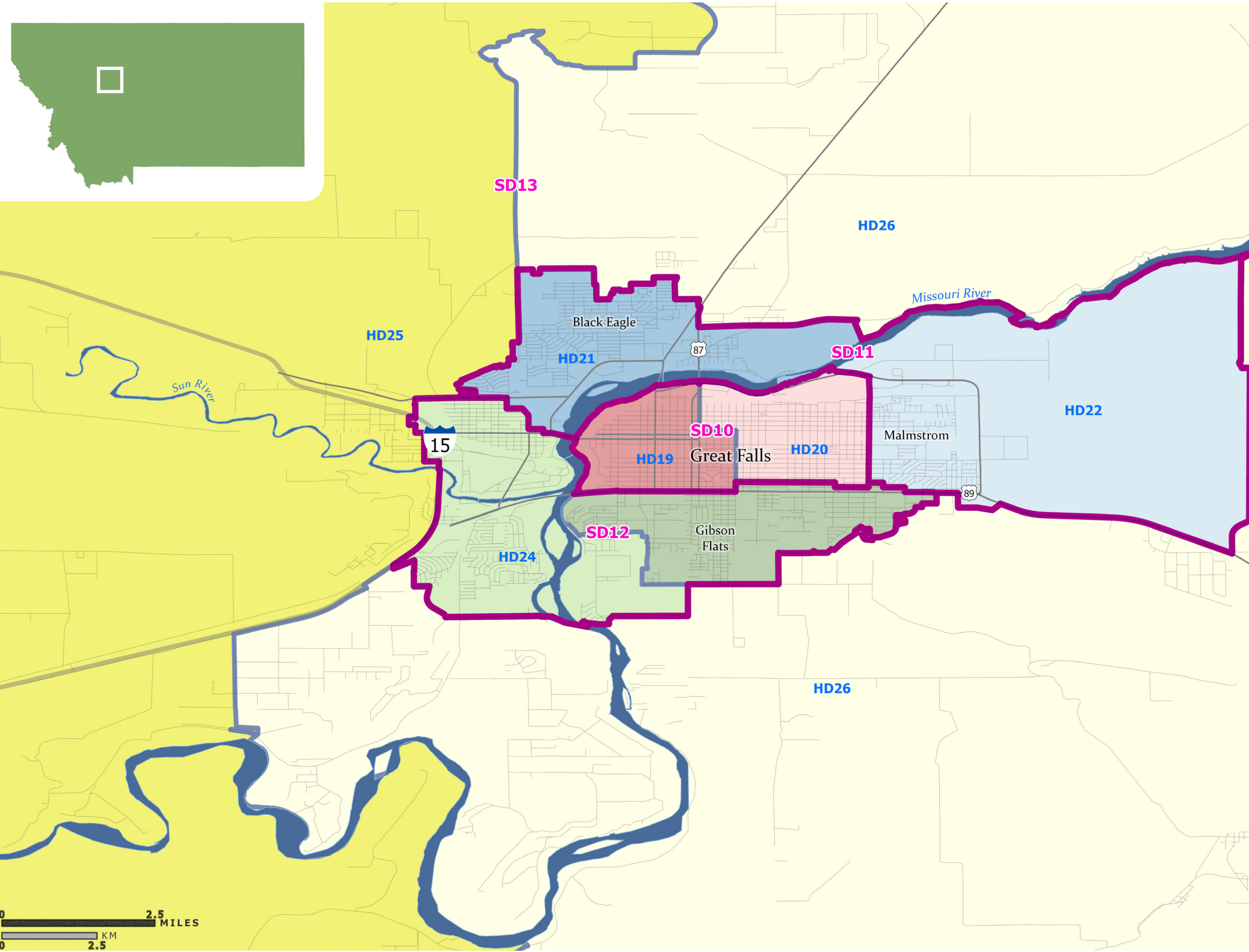
