#### **Connect MT**

- Application window closed April 29<sup>th</sup>; \$270M ARPA funds available for grants
  - 80 applications received serving 156K locations
    - Total Requests: \$521M
    - Total Matching Funds: \$193.9M
    - Total Project Costs: \$704M
- Challenge window closed June 3<sup>rd</sup>; 57 challenges received.
- Next Steps:
  - Validate service areas challenged
  - Rank applications and make funding recommendations to the Communications Advisory Commission and Governor's Office
  - Issue award notices (targeting early August)



A program to expand middle mile infrastructure, to reduce the cost of connecting unserved and underserved areas.

#### BEAD Eligible Entity application includes five key steps

## **Digital Equity Act**

The Digital Equity Act provides \$2.75 billion to establish three grant programs that promote digital equity and inclusion. They aim to ensure that all people and communities have the skills, technology, and capacity needed to reap the full benefits of our digital economy.

- **State Digital Equity Planning Grant Program**: A \$60M formula grant program for states, territories and tribal governments to develop digital equity plans.
- State Digital Equity Capacity Grant Program: A \$1.44 billion formula grant program for states, territories, and tribal governments. It will fund an annual grant program for five years in support of digital equity projects and the implementation of digital equity plans.
- **Digital Equity Competitive Grant Program**: A \$1.25 billion grant program. It will fund annual grant programs for five years to implement digital equity projects.



#### Middle Mile Broadband Infrastructure Grant

- Provides funding for construction, improvement, or acquisition of middle mile infrastructure.
- Purpose is to expand and extend middle mile infrastructure to reduce the cost of connecting areas that are unserved or underserved to the internet backbone.
- \$980,000 available for states, tribes, telcos, utilities, cooperatives, nonprofits, and economic development authorities.



### **IIJA Broadband: Next Steps**

- Submit Letter of Intent to NTIA by 7/18 (complete)
- Submit Digital Equity Planning Grant Application by 7/12 (MT to receive \$601K)
- Develop BEAD 5-Year Action Plan within 270 days
- Launch Statewide Stakeholder Outreach
