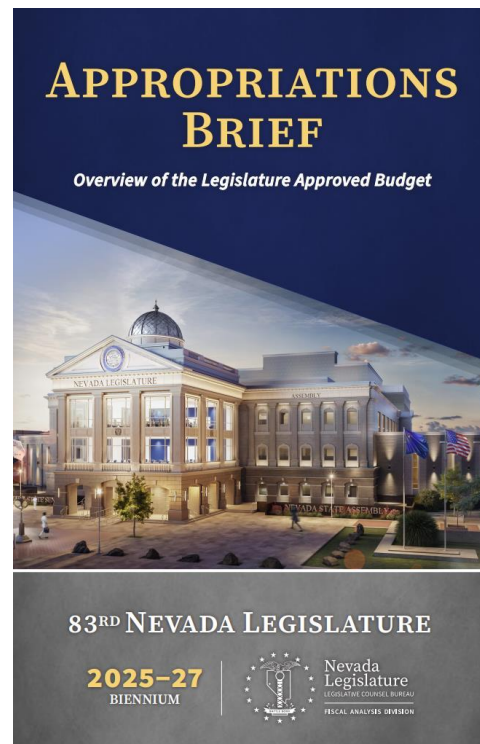
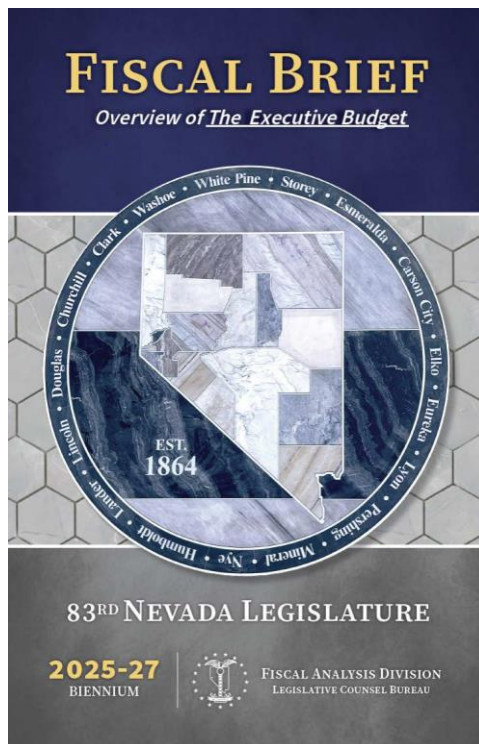


Summary Budget Briefs for Legislators and Other Interested Parties

State of Nevada Presentation – WSLFOA 2025 Conference

- Historically, the Fiscal Analysis Division of the Nevada Legislative Counsel Bureau has produced detailed reports (over 350 pages each on 8.5 x 11 inches paper) on the Governor's recommended budget as submitted to the Legislature, as well as the legislatively approved budget.
- These reports are known as the [Fiscal Report](#) (Governor's recommended budget) and the [Appropriations Report](#) (legislatively approved budget).
- Due to the detail and size of these reports, they are not easy to use as a quick reference document for high-level discussions. Accordingly, there was a desire among legislators to have access to high-level summary budget information in a portable format.
- This led to the creation of the [Fiscal Brief](#) and the [Appropriations Brief](#). Both briefs are approximately 70 pages; are printed on 5.5 x 8.5 inches paper; and include more graphs, charts, and tables than the full reports.



- Both briefs have been well received by legislators and other interested parties. In fact, the Fiscal Brief received the 2025 [Notable Documents Award](#) in the Fiscal Series from the Legislative Research Librarians professional association.
