Project Overview:

- □ Originally established in 2019
- Designed to provide a menu of services to those on community supervision
- Services vary by location

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Program Goals / Data Requirements / Communication with MDOC Staff:

- Providers Electronically Enter All Alcohol & Drug Testing Data Into the MDOC Offender Management Information System (OMIS)
- Information Associated with Each Specific Offender Entered into OMIS
- Daily / Weekly Status Updates to Supervising PO / State of Montana
- Report Failed Drug / Alcohol Test, Failure to Check-in, Etc.
- Issues Reported to Supervising PO within 2 Business Days
- □ Training P&P Staff

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Program Operational Expenses / Concerns:

- □ Transportation
- Dersonnel Costs Wages / Benefits
- Rent / Utilities
- □ Vehicles / Fuel (Rural Locations)
- GPS / Smart Start / SCRAM Units Replacement of Stolen or Destroyed Units – (provider Absorbs Costs at an average of \$300/unit)
- □ THC Positive Participants
- Consequences (Legalization Recreational Marijuana)
- □ P&P Turnover Smaller Communities
- MLEA Training Offered New Officers cannot possess firearm until training complete limits ability to go into field affecting referrals in rural communities
- Sustainability Operational Costs vs. Number of Referrals.



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Daily Cost to house in Prison: Approximately \$115.35/day

ETSS Services Cost: Ranges from \$8.00-\$35.00/service

Offender / Participant Cost: Offenders / Participants not responsible for any cost related to ETSS or ESP

ETSS PROGRAM SUCCESSES AND CHALLENGES

Successes:

Expansive array of services to keep struggling offenders in the community safely.

Low-cost options for supervision, saving tax payer dollars.

Challenges:

Complicated/time consuming billing practices.

Inconsistent referrals

- Mandate all offenders releasing from institutions/community corrections facilities to participate in ETSS Superversion to supplement P&P staff & enhance likelihood of success
- MDOC to share cost related to replacement of Smart Start, GPS, Scram units, etc. (providers need to engage MDOC in this discussion)
- Additional discussion relative to accountability & consequences for offenders with UA's positive for THC
- Reconsideration of fixed rate / slot rate billing vs. piece-meal billing for services
- Consider expansion of services



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RECOMMENDATIONS

Other Possible Future Program Concepts / Considerations:

- Alternative Reporting Centers and/or Altnernative Reporting & Treatment Programs
- □ Staff 7-days-week x 24-hours-per-day
- □ Flat Fixed Rate Contract from MDOC to cover all associated expenses
- □Treatment / Programming:
- ✓ Behavioral Health Peer Support Services
- ✓ Family Services
- Re-Entry Services Housing, Public Assistance, Budgeting, Financial Planning, Veteran Specific, Vocational & Educational
- ✓ Mental Health Services
- ✓ Substance Abuse Treatment
- ✓ Medical / Nursing
- ✓ Short-term housing
- ✓ Transportation
