

If you are a victim of a violent crime, an advocate from the Gallatin County Victim Services will contact you regarding your case.

Advocates offer criminal justice advocacy, assistance with restitution, and referrals to community resources. If there is a criminal case, the advocates offer court support, notification of court proceedings and provide assistance with your case.
